About the role

The Maintenance Technician/ Heavy Equipment Operator is a hands-on position responsible for the regular and preventive maintenance programs of the site's heavy equipment including loaders and excavators. In addition, the position conducts basic maintenance such as tire and oil changes on other site vehicles, as well as site facilities maintenance as directed. The position is also a backup heavy equipment operator. This position is responsible to recommend items for purchase relating to their duties.
