Experience:

- A minimum of 3 years of experience in a compost operation, treatment plant or waste management operation
- Proficient in use of computer software applications such as Microsoft Office, Excel, Outlook, Teams

- Regular hours are Monday to Friday 8:00 am to 4:30 pm (40 hours per week)
- Additional hours will be required periodically depending upon work demands, including Saturdays & Holidays.
- May need to periodically attend meetings outside of regular work hours.
- On-site, office, maintenance shop, treatment plant as well as periodically visiting other locations off-site
- Occasionally lifting heavy objects (up to 50 lbs)
- After-hours calls as required
