The Planner reports to the Manager of Planning and is responsible for providing various tasks relating to municipal planning work including planning programs and projects, short and long range planning initiative and the development and implementation of land-use policies and zoning bylaws. This position facilitates meetings with the public to gain insight from residents and community stakeholders relating to planning initiative within the Municipality of the County of Annapolis. This position requires a bachelor's degree in planning, previous municipal planning experience would be considered an asset.
